## ANC 3F Streets and Sidewalks Committee January 2019 Progress Report to ANC 3F Commissioners

## Streets and Sidewalks Survey, 311 Requests, and Follow-up with DDOT

In late 2017 the Committee entered approximately 250 items in the DC 311 system as a result of its comprehensive survey conducted in mid-2017. Of those 250 items, about 100 are still listed as "open" in the DC 311 system. In addition, the Committee has not determined how to submit requests for new infrastructure, including 40 related to missing sidewalks as noted in the table below. The Committee has repeatedly asked DDOT to assist us with electronic tracking of all submitted 311 items to facilitate easier follow-up on requests. In the DC 311 system, for example, only the 50 most recent requests can be viewed. There has been no response from DDOT for several months.

## **Recent Meetings/Actions**

In March 2018 the Committee approved a resolution to request a DDOT study of Connecticut Avenue traffic issues (including the reversible lanes). ANC 3F adopted a resolution at its March meeting requesting "a Comprehensive Study of Connecticut Avenue Traffic Patterns and Potential Changes." ANC 3C and ANC 3G later adopted similar resolutions on this issue. On November 26, 2018, the Committee hosted DDOT at a community meeting at which DDOT explained its tentative study plans.

At recent meetings, the Committee has begun discussing the need for enforcement at several intersections in ANC 3F, potential requests for red-light cameras, and the increasing problems related to motorized scooters on the sidewalks.

The Committee has established three working subcommittees:

- 1) 311 survey items (follow-up with DDOT);
- 2) Connecticut Avenue study proposal follow-up; and
- 3) Safety and enforcement issues.

## **Summary**

The Committee will continue to: 1) monitor progress on DC 311 items; 3) monitor progress on the Connecticut Avenue study; and 3) follow-up on enforcement and pedestrian safety issues. The Committee generally meets on the second Wednesday of the month. Its next meeting will be February 13, 2019 at 7 pm, in a meeting room at UDC to be announced soon.
