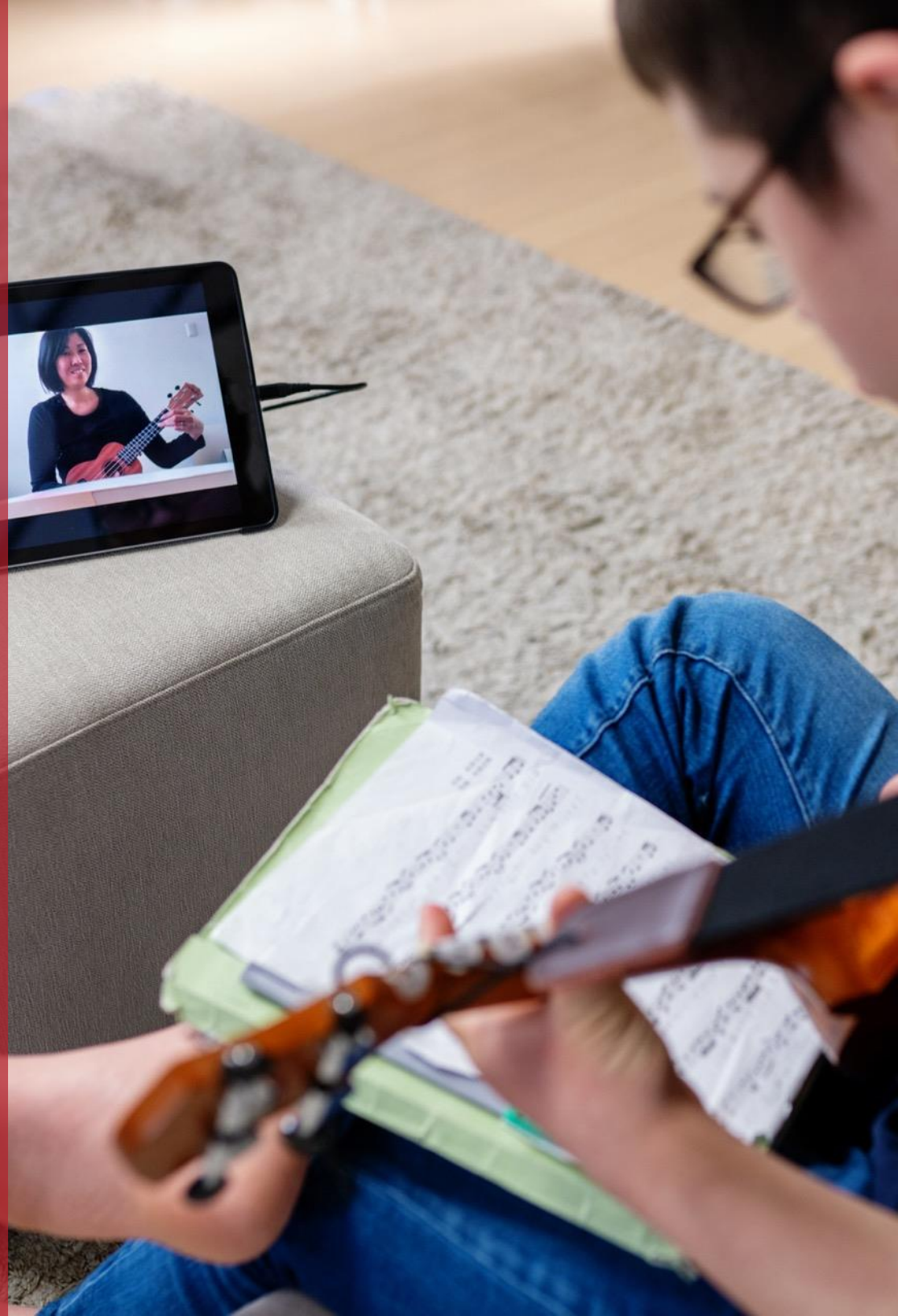


# Education

- No proposed additions or expansion of our building or increase in enrollment cap
- Modest changes to conditions in the order that currently guides school operations:
  - Approval of application will authorize continued use by Levine without a term
  - Extend Saturday hours from 4 pm to 7 pm and eliminate Saturday cap on students
  - Increase the number of Sunday performances from 12 to 36, tracking the school year, for recitals, workshops, performances and small group rehearsals
